

Medicare ABN

Medicare does not pay for all of your health care costs. Medicare only covers those services when Medicare rules are met. Medicare will not pay for Physical Therapy treatment for the following reasons checked below:

- The services provided here will be considered as a management of a maintenance and/ or wellness program, not rehabilitative in nature, under Medicare guidelines. Medicare does not consider these types of programs as reasonable or medically necessary.
- 2. Physical Therapy that occurs less than two to three times per week does not meet Medicare rules.
- 3. The duration of physical therapy services is longer than what Medicare considers reasonable and necessary, which is usually eight weeks.
- 4. You will not be seeing your medical doctor every thirty days.
- 5. Your physical therapist is not a Medicare provider and therefore you will not be able to submit claims to Medicare for reimbursement.
